Methods of the annual prize

The **Foundation Adrian and Simone Frutiger**, non profit-making institution of public interest, was created in Bremgarten on November 15th, 2006, by Adrian and Simone Frutiger. The Foundation awards annually the university prize of the Foundation Adrian and Simone Frutiger, of the order of CHF 20'000.

This prize is awarded following the proposition of the Search Committee appointed by the Foundation Council. It's intended to reward a post-doctoral research work (research paper and file of publications or thesis plus complementary research papers and publications) performed in Switzerland, which makes an important contribution or an international innovation in the field of the neuropsychiatry and of the neuropsychologie, more specifically for young people.

Conditions

To be registered as candidate on the Prize, a file including the following documents must be deposited with the Council of foundation:

- A letter of support for the application, written by a professor of a Swiss University; this letter will have to underline the researcher's qualities of the candidate, by indicating, in particular, its potential capacity to develop and to coordinate, in a near future, high-level researches.
- The name and the address of three international experts external to the home University of the candidate, not directly connected with the candidate and susceptible to prepare a suitable a letter of appreciation on the file.
- The research report.
- A detailed CV.
- The list of the publications to which the candidate participated as main author or co-author.
- A selection of the most significative publications.

The original paper filed has to be complemented with a digital copy in a pdf document or a zip file stored on a CD-ROM.

Deadline

The candidates are proposed by a professor from a swiss University or submit directly their file to the Foundation until March 1st of the current year, at the address of the Foundation such as mentioned in the extract of the Commercial register. Applications will be examined by the Selection Committee, which will submit its proposition to the Foundation.
